Thank you for participating in this program to bring art into our community!

- * Please deliver your art to me, Liz Mayo, administrator of this program, in Building A on **MONDAY JANUARY 30th, between 9-10am.** Please call me at 772-321-5490 if you have any questions, or need to make alternate hanging arrangements.
- * Your work will be displayed in County Administration Building A or B, and you will have a designated space to hang artwork via the Walker Display system:



- *All paintings must be framed and wired for hanging with the artists contact info and title of piece firmly affixed to the back. As a courtesy to visitors and personnel at our public art venues, we ask that artists use discretion in presenting works of the human figure. All work must be tasteful for a government building.
- *All artists are required to sign a Hold Harmless Agreement (to be provided upon delivery) to be able to display in county buildings.
- *Please email to lizmayo@artfullymanaged.com the details of your piece – name, medium, size and price- as a tag will be made. Potential purchasers will contact the Cultural Council for sales and artist contact info. If a sale is made, a minimum suggested donation of 10% of the purchase price to the Cultural Council to further our mission is greatly appreciated. We have had numerous sales!
- *We wish to keep the buildings filled with art. If you wish to change out your piece, or need to remove it for any reason, you may do so at any time- but you **MUST** contact Liz to make those arrangements. The installations change out about every 3-4 months, I will email you with those details as the date gets closer.
